Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Bangkok - Pattaya

On arrival at the Suvarnabhumi International airport, you will be met and taken to the coach station for your transfer to Pattaya. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel. Later in the evening, we recommend you see the Alcazar Show (optional). Every night, dazzling performances by artists in glittering evening gowns thrill audiences, as they mime and dance against a back-drop of surround-sound and computerized lighting.

Day 02: Pattaya

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Cairo

Upon arrival in Cairo, get transferred to the hotel. Check in to the hotel and relax during the day. In the evening, watch the history of the ancient Egyptians unfold in the Sound and Light Show at the Pyramids of Giza.

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 02: Cairo

After breakfast, proceed for city tour of Cairo, visit the Great Pyramids of Giza, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Egyptian Museum, Khan El Khalil Bazaar, once known as the Turkish bazaar during the Ottoman period, is now usually just called the "Khan". The rest of the day is at leisure.

Overnight in Cairo. (B)

Day 03: Cairo - Aswan - Nile Cruise

After breakfast, you will be transferred from the hotel to the airport for your flight to Aswan. Arrive in Aswan and get transferred to the cruise terminal. Embark on the Nile Cruise and visit the High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk and Philae Temple.

Overnight on the cruise. (B, L, D)

Day 04: Nile Cruise

Visit the unique Kom Ombo temple which is dedicated to two Gods. The Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple built during the Ptolemaic dynasty in the Egyptian town of Kom Ombo. Sail onto Edfu and visit the mammoth temple of Horus. The temple includes a colossal statue of Horus as a falcon, which stands at the entrance to the main temple building.

Overnight on the cruise. (B, L, D)



Day 05: Nile Cruise

Today, visit East Bank of Luxor. You'll see two of the most impressive temples in Upper Egypt - Overnight on the cruise. (B, L, D)

Day 06: Nile Cruise-Luxor - Hurghada

After breakfast, disembark from the cruise and depart to Hurghada by coach. Check in to the hotel. Hurghada, known locally as Ghardaga, has grown from a small fishing village to an internationally renowned holiday resort town, famous for its underwater life, diving and snorkeling.

Day 07: Hurghada

Today your day is free at leisure. You can opt to take a snorkeling trip at Giftun Island. Swim with the dolphins before docking at Giftun Island for sports. In the evening, you have free time to enjoy the unique nightlife of Hurghada.
